The purpose and legal basis of data processing

Data security

In the course of processing your personal data, we ensure the security of your information, and we take all reasonable technical and organisational measures and implement the procedural rules necessary for fulfilling the requirements of the relevant legal provisions. Accordingly, we

take appropriate measures to protect your information, particularly against unauthorised access, modification, forwarding, disclosure, deletion or destruction, as well as against accidental loss or corruption and becoming inaccessible due to changes in the technology used.

Your data processing-related rights and your options for exercising your rights

You can request information about the way your data is handled at any time, you can request for your data to be modified, corrected or deleted, and you have the right to partially or completely revoke your consent for processing the data you have provided. The Infolaw provides for the possible legal remedies concerning data processing. Accordingly, we advise you that in case the laws of data processing are violated, you have the right to file a complaint concerning unlawful data processing with us, and you can request an investigation by the Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (postal address: 22/c Szilágyi Erzsébet fasor, Budapest 1125, email: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu; phone: +36 (1) 391-1400; website: <http://www.naih.hu>), or, according to the provisions of Section 22 of the Infolaw, you have the right to appeal to a court in case of illegal data processing. If you decide to go to court, you can file a suit with the Court of your place of residence or stay.
